The shell eggs covered by this certificate were produced by birds originating from <u>Salmonella</u> <u>enteritidis (SE)</u> -certified breeding flocks which have not been identified within 90 days before shipment by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, as being infected with <u>SE</u>, including <u>SE</u> phage type 4."

The shell eggs covered by this certificate meet U.S. Department of Agriculture, Agricultural Marketing Service quality grade standards. To meet this grade standard, shell eggs for human consumption undergo a washing procedure that includes a sanitizing step to address exterior grade defects which also addresses surface risks associated with Salmonella Typhimurium.
